

SMT Games, Inc. Privacy Policy

Last Updated: July 18, 2024

This privacy policy describes our policies and procedures on the collection, use and disclosure of your information when you use the service and tells you about your privacy rights. We use your personal data to provide and improve the service. By using the service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this privacy policy.

Definitions

For the purposes of this privacy policy:

- "Affiliate" means an entity that controls, is controlled by or is under common control with a party, where "control" means ownership of 50% or more of the shares, equity interest or other securities entitled to vote for election of directors or other managing authority.
- "Application" refers to Super Tiny Football, the software program provided by the company. Company (referred to as either "the company," "we," "us" or "our" in this agreement) refers to SMT Games, Inc., 3511 University Drive, Durham, N.C., 27707.
- "Country" refers to United States.
- "Device" means any device that can access the service, such as a mobile phone, computer or digital tablet.
- "Personal data" is any information that is specific to the user but is not personally identifying information.
- "Service" refers to the application.
- "Service provider" means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the
 company. It refers to third-party companies or individuals employed by the company to facilitate
 the service, to provide the service on behalf of the company, to perform services related to the
 service or to assist the company in analyzing how the service is used.
- "Usage data" refers to data collected automatically, either generated by the use of the service or from the service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit, session length, session count and game telemetry such as games played and games won).
- "You" means the individual accessing or using the service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the service, as applicable.

Collecting and Using Your Personal Data

We only collect the minimum amount of personal information that is necessary to fulfill the intended purpose of your use of the application. We do not sell or distribute any personal information of users to third parties.

Types of Data Collected

Usage data may be collected automatically when using the service.

Use of Your Personal Data

The company may use personal data for the following purposes:



- to provide and maintain our service, including to monitor the usage of our service
- for the performance of a contract: the development, compliance and undertaking of a purchase contract for the products, items or services you may have purchased or of any other contract with us through the service
- to provide you with news, special offers and general information about other goods, services and events which we offer that are similar to those that you have already purchased or inquired about unless you have opted not to receive such information
- to manage your requests: to attend and manage your requests to us
- for other purposes: We may use your information for other purposes, such as data analysis, identifying usage trends, determining the effectiveness of our promotional campaigns and to evaluate and improve our service, products, services, marketing and your experience.

Retention of Your Personal Data

The company will retain your personal data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy. We will retain and use your personal data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

The company may also retain usage data for internal analysis purposes. Usage data is generally retained for a shorter period of time, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods.

Transfer of Your Personal Data

Your information, including personal data, may be processed at the company's operating offices and in any other places where the parties involved in the processing are located. It means that this information may be transferred to — and maintained on — computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ than those from your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this privacy policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

The company will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy and no transfer of your personal data will take place to an organization or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of your data and other personal information.

Delete Your Personal Data

You have the right to delete or request that we assist in deleting the personal data that we have collected about you.

Our service may give you the ability to delete certain information about you from within the service.

You may update, amend or delete your information at any time by signing into your account, if you have one, and visiting the account settings section that allows you to manage your personal information. You may also contact us to request access to, correct or delete any personal information that you have provided to us.



Please note, however, that we may need to retain certain information when we have a legal obligation or lawful basis to do so.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data

Law Enforcement

Under certain circumstances, the company may be required to disclose your personal data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities (e.g., a court or a government agency).

Other Legal Requirements

The company may disclose your personal data in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to:

- comply with a legal obligation.
- protect and defend the rights or property of the company.
- prevent or investigate possible wrongdoing in connection with the service.
- protect the personal safety of users of the service or the public.
- · protect against legal liability.

Security of Your Personal Data

The security of your personal data is important to us but remember that no method of transmission over the internet, or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Children's Privacy

We do not knowingly collect personally identifiable information from anyone under the age of 16. If you are a parent or guardian and you are aware that your child has provided us with personal data, please contact us. If we become aware that we have collected personal data from anyone under the age of 16, we will delete that information.

Links to Other Websites

Our service may contain links to other websites that are not operated by us. If you click on a third-party link, you will be directed to that third party's site. We have no control over and assume no responsibility for the content, privacy policies or practices of any third-party sites or services.

California Residents

The California Consumer Privacy Act or "CCPA" provides consumers residing in California certain rights with respect to their personal information. If you are a California resident, you may have the right to: (1) request to know more about the categories and specific pieces of personal information we collect, use, and disclose; (2) request deletion of your personal information; (3) opt out of sale of your personal information (if any); and (4) not be discriminated against for exercising these rights.

You or your authorized agent may make these requests by contacting us as described in "Contact Us" below. Note that we may ask you for additional information to help us verify who you are before completing your request. If we receive your request from an authorized agent, we may ask for evidence



that you gave that person authority to submit requests to exercise rights on your behalf. We will not discriminate against you if you exercise your rights under the CCPA.

Residents of the European Economic Area, the United Kingdom and Switzerland

If you're located in the European Economic Area (EEA), the United Kingdom (UK), or Switzerland, you have certain rights regarding how your personal data is processed.

Data Subject Rights

You may have the right to access, correct or delete personal data we have collected about you through the services. You may also have the right to a portable copy of the personal data you have provided and to object to or restrict processing of your personal data, such as for direct marketing. Where you have provided your consent to our data processing, you have the right to withdraw consent. You also have the right to make a complaint by contacting your local supervisory authority for data protection (if one exists in your country). We would, however, appreciate the chance to address your concerns before you contact a data protection regulator and ask that you please direct your complaint to us first.
